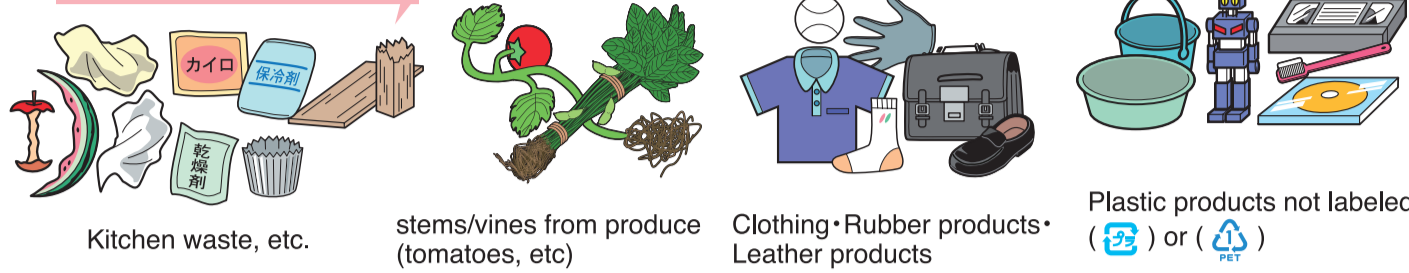

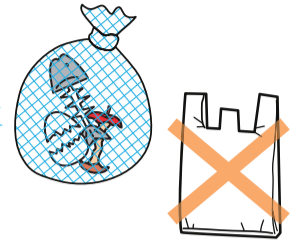

- Designated trash bag (yellow) required for collection



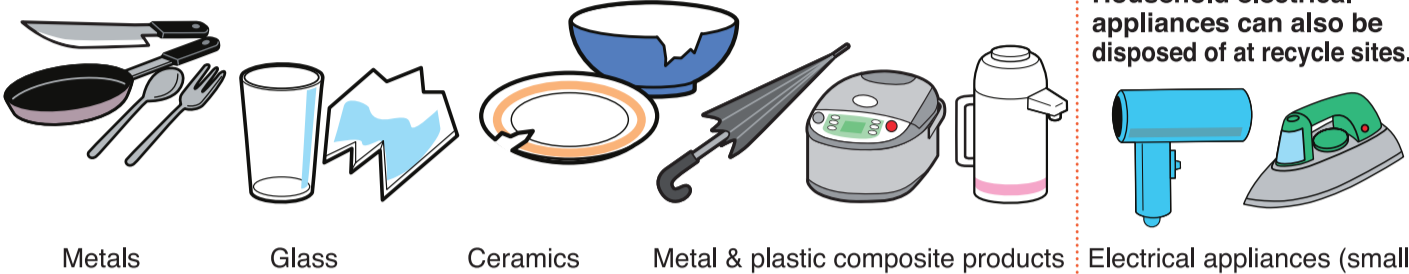

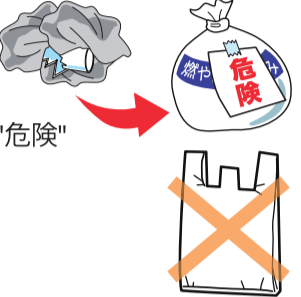

- Designated trash bag (clear) required for collection



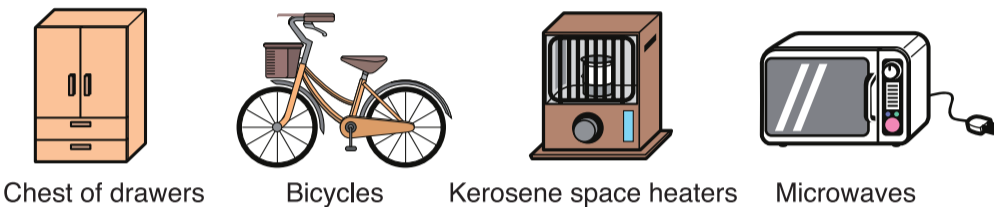
Oversized Household Waste

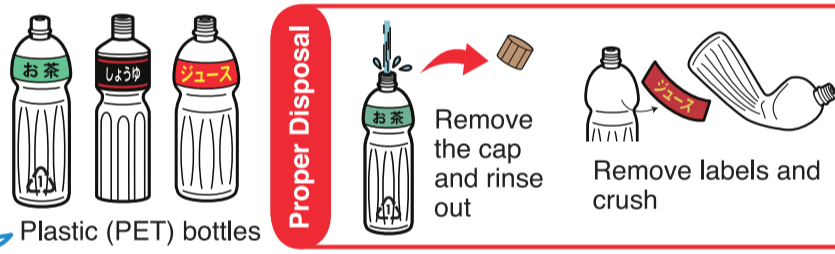

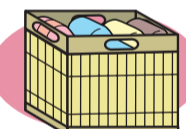

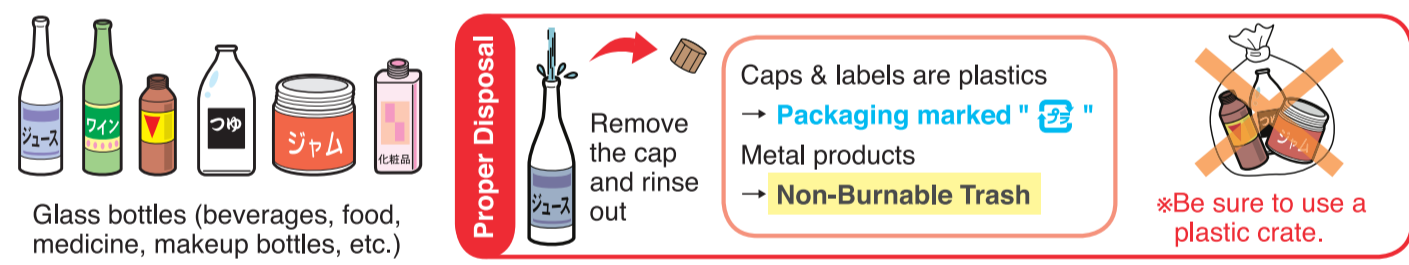
Empty glass bottles

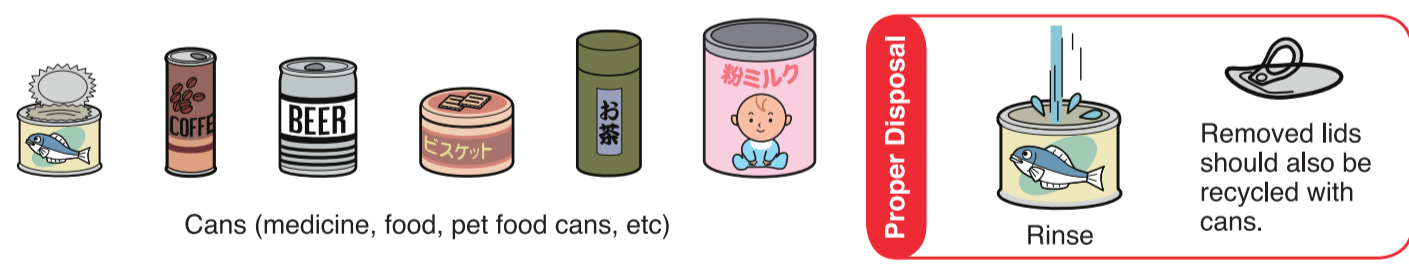

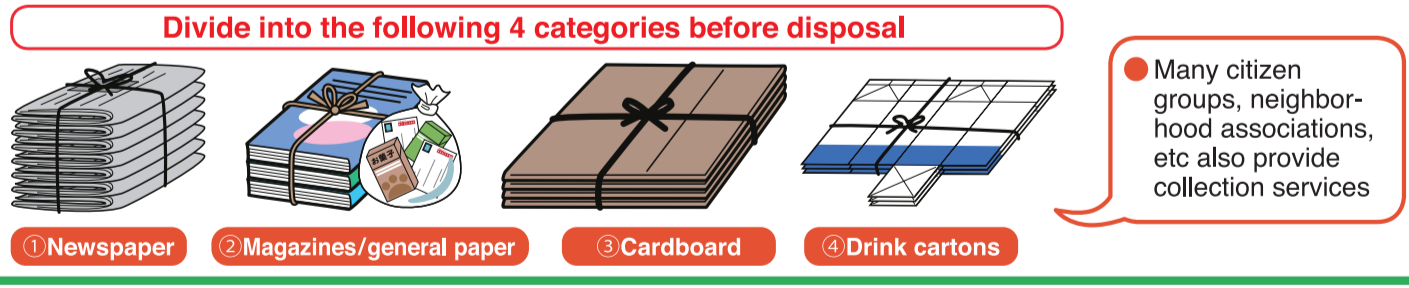
Paper products (4 categories)

Use colorless, transparent/semi-transparent plastic bags for paper that can't be easily tied.

Non-Recyclable Items

Tissue paper, soiled paper, wax paper (paper cups), thermal paper, carbon paper, pictures, paper with aluminum coating, etc.
→ **Burnable Trash**

Plant waste (branches, grass, etc)



Tie into bundles

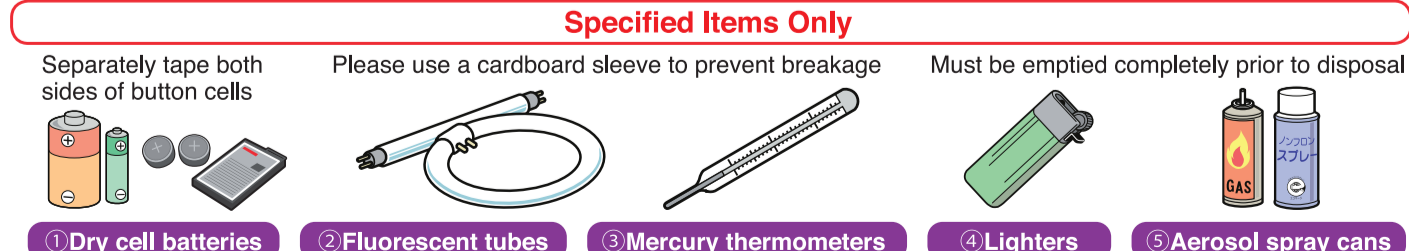

Non-Recyclable Items

Incandescent lights
Glass

Garbage will still be collected on Nat. holidays (except Jan. 1 ~3)

Dec. 31= **Burnable Trash** collection only
